

Concrete Furniture Sealing

Congratulations on your new concrete furniture purchase.

It is recommended that a high quality penetrating sealer (Such as Fila W68) is applied to prevent excessive water absorption and to minimise staining from grease/oils and other contaminants.

Fila W68. What's it for:

- Seals and protects porous materials such as rough-finish natural stone, terracotta and cement from oily dirt.
- Drastically reduces absorption of the surface without altering its appearance.
- Suitable for interior and exterior surfaces.

To seal your concrete furniture, simply follow the steps below.



What you will need:

Fila W68. Brush. White Rag. Tray



Step 1

Apply a thin coat of Fila W68 to a section of the furniture. Allow sealer to penetrate for 5 minutes



Step 2

Remove any residue after 5 minutes using a clean white cloth in a circular motion. Continue sealing table in sections removing residues as per previous steps.



Step 3

Seal edges of table and remove residues after 5 minutes with cloth as per previous steps.

How often do I re-seal my furniture?

It all depends on environmental conditions but the recommendation is anywhere from 6 months to 1 year

What happens if my table still stains after I have sealed it?

If oil/grease is left on the table for an extended period it can still absorb, however the sealer will hold the stain high in the concrete which allows for easier removal. We recommend using Fila No Spot for stubborn oil stains. Use diluted Fila Cleaner for general maintenance.
